1	As per the EOI documents, the bidder is required to submit Demand Drafts towards the Tender Fee and Empanelment Fee. However, the documents do not specify in whose favour the Demand Drafts are to be drawn or the payable branch/location. Hence, kindly clarify the same.	As per EOI (Clause no. 3.8.4)
2.	Kindly clarify whether the bid is to be submitted online only, or if physical submission of all bid documents is also required.	As per EOI (clause 3.1, and 3.4)

5.	Section 2.2: Whether a single OEM can apply for empanelment under multiple categories (3D Projection Mapping, Façade & Monument Lighting, Thematic Illumination).	This EOI is non-restrictive, and any entity fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria may participate.
6.	Annexure 1A–1E: OEMs execute projects through authorized system integrators. Please clarify if such projects will be considered as OEM experience.	Only experience in the name of the bidder shall be considered.
7.	Annexure 1A–1E: Whether OEMs can apply for higher financial category based on turnover and manufacturing capacity even if single project value differs	This EOI is non-restrictive, and any entity fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria may participate.
8.	Section 8.3: Clarification on eligibility of OEMs having global manufacturing with Indian subsidiary	Only experience in the name of the bidder shall be considered.
9.	Section 3.4: Whether detailed product datasheets, photometric reports, mock-ups are required at EOI stage.	Not at this stage
10.	Section 2.3: Clause mentions “exclusive rights to BECIL” for OEMs. Please clarify scope of exclusivity.	BECIL shall retain exclusive rights over all project-related documents, including the MAF and other associated documents.
11.	Section 2.1.2: Whether empanelled OEMs may later form consortium/JV during project-specific RFPs.	This will be decided by BECIL at the time of project specific RFP, based on requirements of the project/RFP.
12.	Section 2.2.2 & 2.2.3: OEMs typically provide warranty & technical support but not site O&M. Please clarify OEM role.	O&M will need to be provided by the empaneled agency, selected through project specific RFP, as per requirement of the project.
13.	Section 6.2: Whether global reference projects and technology ownership will be considered in evaluation.	The marking will be as per promulgated criteria of the EOI.

14.	Section 7.2: Please clarify whether Security Deposit is required only post-empanelment.	Yes, as per clause 7.2.1. Security deposit is required to be submitted post issuance of LOI, but before signing of MOU for empanelment.
15.	Section 9.6: Whether OEM branding can be used in DPRs and presentations with client approval.	This will be decided by BECIL at the time of project specific RFP, based on requirements of the project/RFP.
16.	Section 3.4.2(b): Confirmation that no financial bid is required at EOI stage.	Yes, as per EOI
17.	With reference to Annexure 1C (Project Value ranging from INR 30 Cr to 60 Cr) and Annexure 1D (Project Value ranging from INR 60 Cr to 100 Cr), we request clarification on whether separate applications are required for each category. Alternatively, if a bidder applies for and is empanelled under the higher project value category, will the bidder automatically be eligible to participate in projects under the lower value category as well?	Bidder empanelled for higher category are considered for lower project values also.
18.	We would also like to understand whether a bidder is permitted to apply for empanelment under more than one category simultaneously.	Higher category only. Bidder empanelled for higher category are considered for lower project values also.
19.	As per the RFP, shortlisted bidders are required to submit a Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank. However, as per the marking scheme, the solvency requirement specifies Nationalized Banks. We wish to clarify whether a Bank Solvency Certificate issued by Yes Bank Ltd. (a Scheduled Commercial Bank), with whom we have been maintaining our banking relationship for the past 23 years, would be acceptable for meeting the solvency requirement.	Scheduled banks listed in RBI are also considered.
20.	We request confirmation on whether the tender is required to be submitted in offline mode only, or if any part of the submission (technical or financial) is to be made online as well.	As per EOI, clause 3.1 and 3.4
